Provide ASME A112.19.5 trim and ASME 112.6.1M concealed chair carriers. Provide self-closing metering type flush valve, unless electronic control is specified in the ESR Section D20. Handicapped fixture mounting height and appurtenances shall be in accordance with ANSI A117"

shall be deleted and replaced with:

3) "Equipment Warranty Tags and Guarantor's Local Representative: The Contractor shall furnish with each warranty, the name, address, and telephone number of the guarantor's representative nearest to the location where the Plant and Materials are installed. The guarantor's representative, upon request of the Employer's unit representative, shall honor the warranty during the extended warranty period and shall provide the services prescribed by the terms of the warranty. At the time of installation, the Contractor shall tag each item of warranted equipment with a durable, oil-and water-resistant tag approved by the Employer's Representative. The Contractor shall attach the tag with copper wire and spray the tag with a clear silicone waterproof coating. The Contractor shall leave the date of acceptance and quality control's signature blank until the issuance of the Performance Certificate. The tag shall show the information shown in Table No. 1, included at the end of this Section.

For fenders, as an alternative to a tag, the Contractor may use as identification information a string of numbers incorporated in the mold with a unique serial number for each fender which can be easily traceable following standard marine fender procedures. The warranty tag information shall be provided in an electronic database and one hard copy."

- 7. The Parties agree that, save as expressly stated in this Variation Agreement No. 167 the Contractor shall have no claims for additional time or any other relief or entitlement of any kind as a direct consequence of this Variation Agreement No. 167 or arising out of it or in any way in connection with it.

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8. This Variation Agreement No. 167 shall be governed by the Laws of the Republic of Panama and is deemed to be incorporated into and form an integral part of the Contract.
